

SELLING YOUR VEHICLE - IF YOU GET CASH FOR YOUR CAR TECHNICALLY YOU ARE SELLING YOUR VEHICLE

IT'S THE LAW

You as the seller are legally obliged to get the new owner to fill out their name address and contact details complete with their signature on the reverse of the VLC /Logbook (RF101) If a company is buying your vehicle, **they must provide** their CRO registration number.

PROTECT YOURSELF

It has been brought to our attention that some operators are putting an incorrect name and/or address on the VLC (logbook). If this happens the VLC will then come back to you as the owner along with the possibility of:

1. Speeding Tickets / Points on your Licence
2. Toll Fees
3. Parking Fines
4. Private Parking Fees
5. Insurance Fraud
6. Criminal Activity

CHECKLIST IF YOU ARE GETTING CASH FOR YOUR VEHICLE

While the new owner is entitled to the VLC (Logbook) **you should never** hand over the VLC (Logbook) directly to the new owner.

1. Always verify the new owners name, address and contact details by **photographic ID.** (keep a copy/photo of the logbook)
2. You as the seller should **never hand over** the VLC (Logbook) to the new owner.
3. You should post the Vehicle Logbook directly to;
